Yejiro Yamasaki. Born in Japan in 1870 and arrived in Australia in 1894. Tai Yanasaki wife of Yejiro was born in Japan in 1878 and joined her husband in Broome in 1895. Yejiro became a merchant & publisher of post cards.

In 1903 for the Fifty Five Pounds sterling he was granted by the W.A. Governor Sir Frederick G.D. Bedford, lot 388 Carnarvon St. Yejiro Yamasaki his heirs & assigns were to pay on March 25th each year a peppercorn rent.

Yejiro travelled alone overseas in 1908 accompanied by Tai in 1910 and alone in 1911
